

# Applying for the More at Four Pre-Kindergarten program is easy!

## 1. Fill out Application

A More at Four Pre-Kindergarten Application must be completed! The following documentation is required before the application is accepted:

\_\_\_\_\_ Birth Certificate

\_\_\_\_\_ Proof of Residency (mortgage statement, lease contract, utility bill)

Applications with missing information will not be reviewed until all information has been received.

## 3. Wait!

After your child's application is received, you will be notified by mail if your child is eligible for the More at Four Pre-Kindergarten program. Eligibility does not guarantee a space in the program. Your patience is appreciated throughout this process!

## 4. If Eligible

You will be notified by phone or mail if a space is available for your child. Placement of children into a More at Four Pre-Kindergarten classroom typically happens during the summer months. Again, your patience is appreciated throughout this process.

**\*Sometimes phone numbers and addresses change during the months before school starts. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO NOTIFY US IF YOUR PHONE NUMBER OR ADDRESS CHANGES!! CALL 342-9676 TO REGISTER ANY CHANGES.**

### Hours of Operation

The More at Four Pre-Kindergarten Program operates on a schedule similar to the public schools. Please note daily operating hours will differ from site to site. Children must be dropped off and picked up on time each day.

### Wraparound Care

Some of the sites offer before and after school care and extended care on days when class is not in session. Extended care is not available at all sites and fees are charged for this service. The fees are determined by the site and parents must make arrangements with the center director. If you have a child care subsidy voucher from DSS, talk to your case manager about vouchers for extended care. If you give up your voucher, you may be placed on a waiting list to receive financial assistance for extended care fees.

The More at Four Calendar- Holidays, teacher workdays and snow days follow the schedule for Rockingham County Schools. The More at Four program will schedule additional teacher workdays when children do not attend school for the purpose of conducting parent meetings, home visits, and/or staff development.

**All sites will provide a calendar for parents with schedules, closings, and holidays.**

Transportation- Parents are responsible for providing transportation for their child. However, if transportation is a barrier to your child's attendance, please talk with your child's teacher or the Parent Counselor at the Rockingham County Partnership for Children. They may be able to help you find ways to get your child to and from school.
